## **Book-in-a-Box**

- 1. Trace the bottom of the box on one end of the paper strip.
- 2. Make nine more side-by-side tracings so that you'll have a long strip with ten sections.
- 3. Cut out this paper strip.
- 4. Leave the first section of the strip blank. Write the title and author of your book on the second section.
- 5. In sections 3–9, illustrate seven important events from your book in order. Leave the last section blank.
- 6. On the opposite side of each illustration, write a sentence or two describing the event you illustrated.
- 7. Accordion-fold the strip. (Trim the strip a little, if necessary, to make sure that it will fit in the box.)
- 8. Write the title and author of your book on the box lid. Decorate the box.
- 9. Glue the first section of the paper strip to the inside of the box lid. Glue the last section to the bottom of the box.
- 10. Hold the lid above the box. Slowly refold the paper strip until it is entirely inside the box. Then cover the box with its lid.
